Message from the President

Assalamulaykum Dear Sponsor,

2020 was a very challenging year in all respects. Due to the lockdown, our school families suffered a lot financially as many are daily wage workers. First, we needed to take care of their well-being. We were able to provide provisions to our school families through the generosity of a few private donors. Since our Academy's core goals are Education, our funds cannot be used for relief work. But Alhumdulillah thru a few philanthropists' generosity, we were able provide grocery packages to over 800+ students and staff families. We were also able to partner with other NGOs like IMRC to make sure our school families benefited from their relief work.

Next, our team of Academy members and Staff creatively provided education to the students according to circumstances. Because our students' financial conditions, most of them do not have a computer or Wi-Fi at home. Our teachers got creative with recording video lessons daily and shared via WhatsApp. Students who didn't have smart phones were provided with one. Elementary students picked up HW and worksheets from school premises to take home. The sincere hard work of our Staff and Secretary deserves appreciation to continue the classes without disruption.

Alhamdulillah, this year, Madinatul Ilm Academy has completed 24 years of service to underprivileged students of Mustafa Nagar and Hasan Nagar, both slum areas of Hyderabad City, India. With the grace of Allah swt we are making concrete progress to eradicate illiteracy from these slum areas. It gives us great joy to see our students pursuing College Education as well as Graduate Studies. Some have opted for Engineering, Pharmacy, Alternative Medicine (Unani), and Paramedical certifications. They are also getting employed in their related fields. Currently, three of our students are enrolled in Engineering and four are in Paramedical courses. There are a total of 68 students enrolled in College.

Your support is appreciated and we rely on it to continue our work for two High Schools with a strength of 800+ students and 40+ teachers and staff. I am grateful to Allah swt for giving me the opportunity to serve this great cause.

Wishing you and your family a blessed and safe Ramadan.

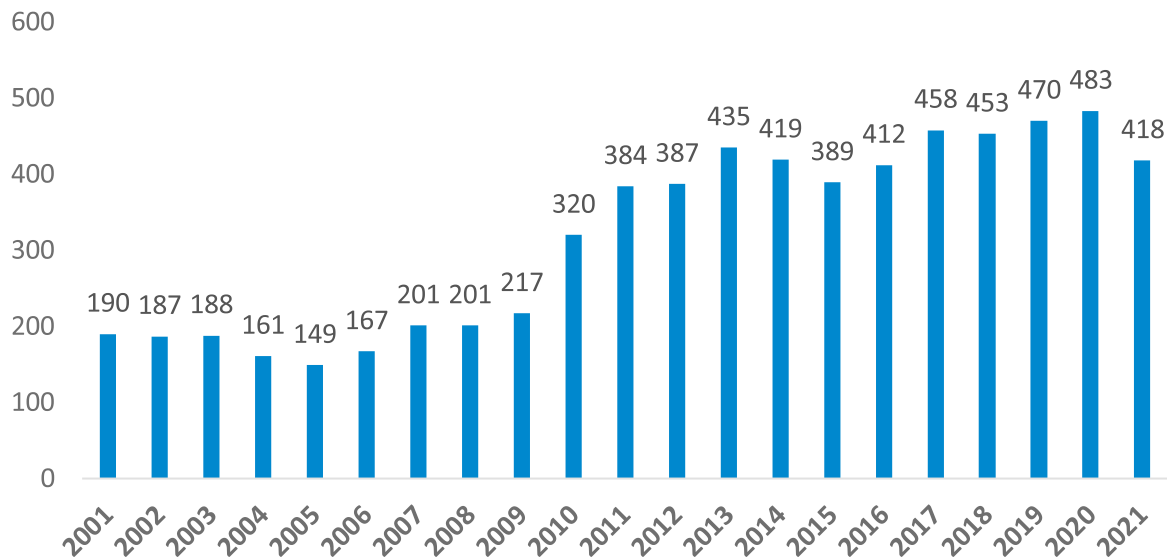

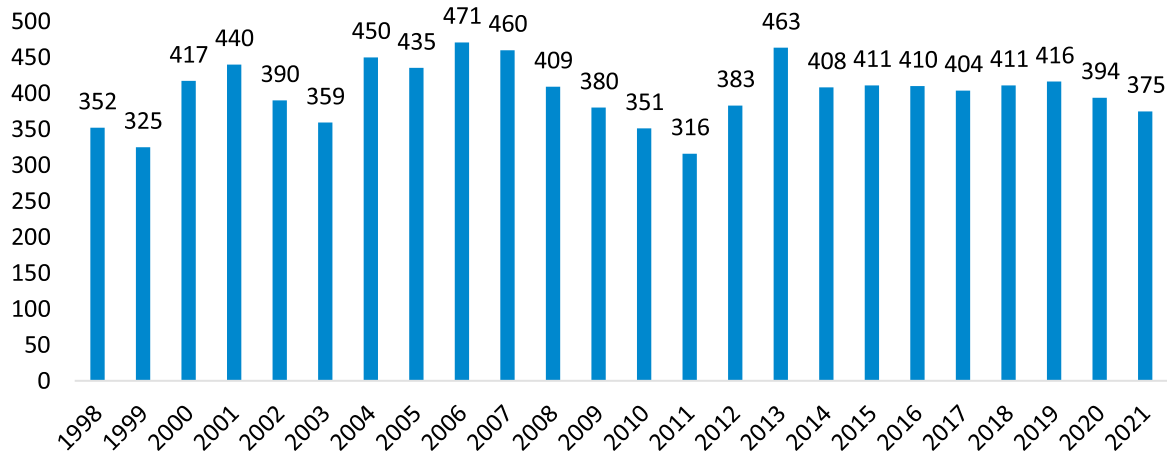

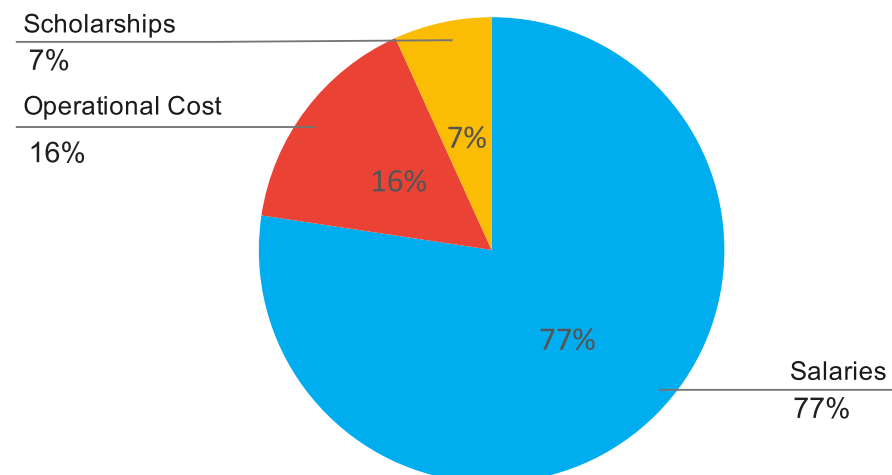
