# Message from the President

Assalamualaikum Dear Sponsor,

Alhumdulillah, this year Madinatul Ilm Academy has completed 25 years of service to underprivileged students of Mustafa Nagar and Hasan Nagar, both slum areas of Hyderabad city, India. With the grace of Allah (swt), we are making significant progress to eradicate illiteracy from these slum areas. There's good progress in students pursuing College Education as well as Professional Courses. The students who are completing professional courses and Paramedical certifications are getting employed in their fields. There are a total of 99 students enrolled in college, compared to 68 in 2020.

As the pandemic continued in 2021, so did the challenges with remote learning. We got only 175 working days instead of the standard 220. Therefore, in-person classes could not be held for the entire school year. However, our team of academic members and staff creatively provided education to the students, according to the circumstances. When there were online classes, some of our students with financial problems did not have a computer or Wi-Fi at home. Our teachers got creative with recording video lessons, and shared them via WhatsApp. Some students who did not have smartphones were provided with one. The sincere efforts of our Staff and Secretary allowed both schools to continue classes during Covid period.

Our Board of Directors decided to improve the Nutrition Program by providing healthy snacks twice a week. All students are below the poverty line and majority of them come to school without eating breakfast. Therefore we felt the need to start an ongoing Nutrition program which will facilitate good attentiveness in school. The estimated cost for serving 800+ students a healthy snack twice a week will be about \$1000 a month, making it around \$10,000 per year for both schools.

Your support is much appreciated and we rely on it to continue our work for our 2 high schools with a strength of almost 800 students, and 40+ teachers and staff. I am grateful to Allah (swt) for giving me the opportunity to serve the academy for the education of underprivileged students.

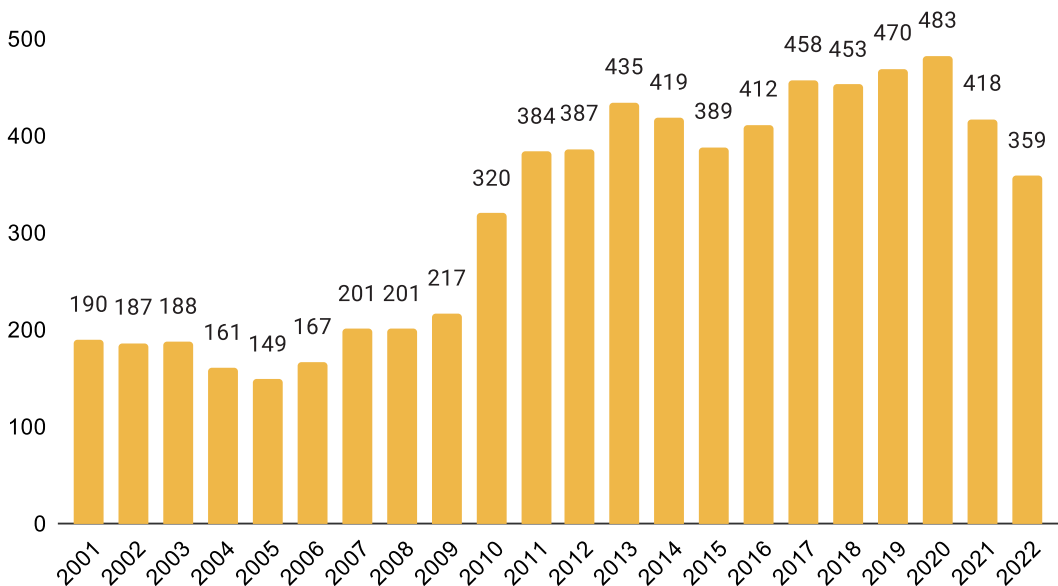

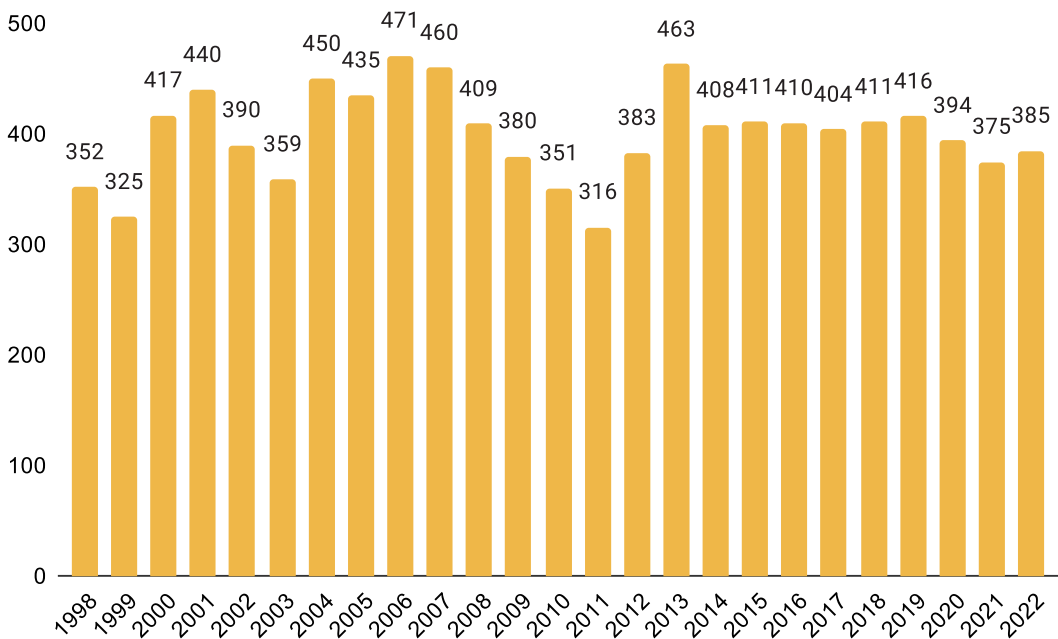

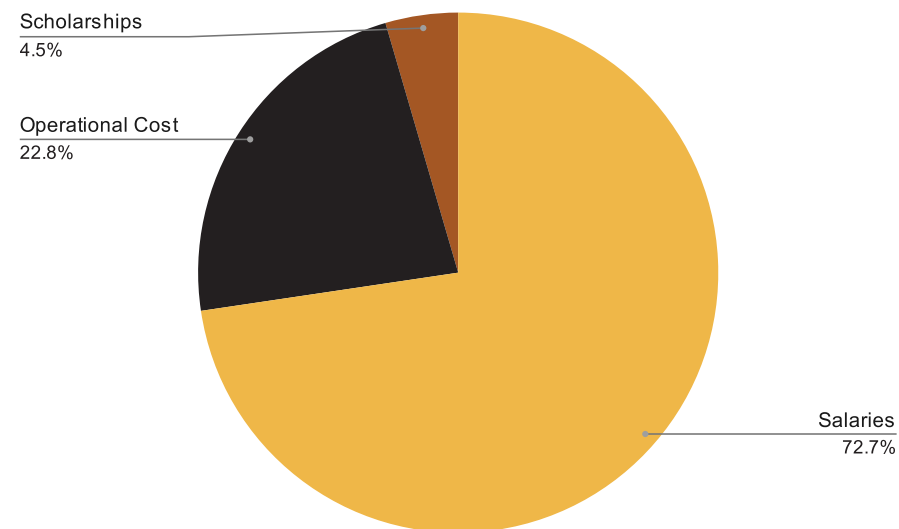
